Root → aer : AIR

- ① aerobics → are exercises that improve the body's use of oxygen or air
- ② aeronautics → designing, building, and flying of airplanes and space vehicles
- ③ aerate → you supply it with or expose it to circulating air
- ④ aerodynamics → the study of air movement and how objects moving through air are affected by the forces of air movement

Root → lith : STONE/ROCK

- ① lithograph → a print made by transferring an image from stone or metal to paper
- ② monolith → a large block of stone, used for a monument, memorial, or column
↳ one

early part
③ Paleolithic → period of time, "Old Stone Age"
≡ 2.5 million years ago, chipped to make tools

last part
④ Neolithic → period of time, "New Stone Age"
≡ started grinding + polishing stone to make tools

Root → agri : FIELD

- ① agriculture → practice of farming, growing crops + raising livestock
- ② agrarian → rural, agricultural, or related to farming and farmland, (soil for food)

Suffix → -ic : having the characteristics of, made of, or related to
